Message from the Administration

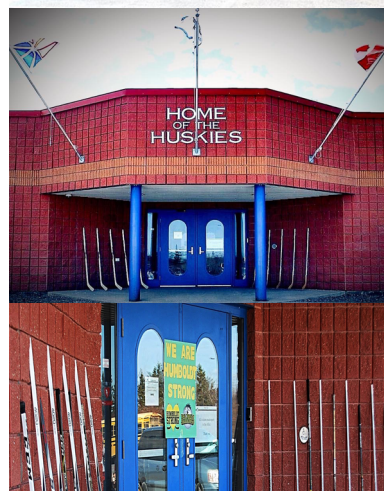

Table Tennis

Table Tennis continues to grow at Heritage Collegiate! We had nearly 30 players in our Table Tennis Club which ran from late November to March. Our Senior Team (consisting of mostly juniors) won the SSNL Avalon West Varsity Table Tennis Regional Championship. From there we went on to represent Avalon West at the SSNL Varsity Table Tennis Provincials hosted by Roncalli Central High School in Avondale. Our Huskies played well and fell just short of the semis in the team competition.

In March, we hosted our Second Annual Table Tennis Invitational Tournament for students in the Vista Region from grades 4-9. We had 60 players compete in 6 categories.

We are currently offering six weeks of Advanced Skill Development Training Sessions (on Monday evenings) for our table tennis players who wish to work on refining their skills and improving their game. Special thanks to Jamie Hibbs, Eastern Representative for the NLTTA and coach of the Eastern Team at the 2018 NL Winter Games, for leading these sessions. 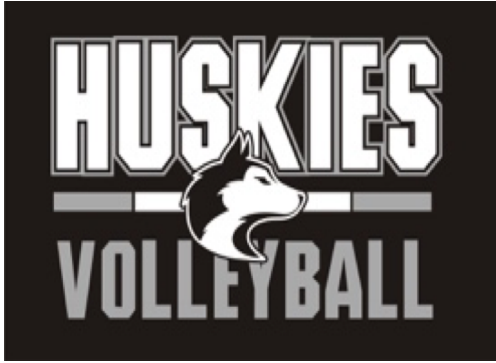
