Code of conduct for Extra-curricular Groups and Activities

Subject to the terms of this contract, you have been selected as a potential member of an extra-curricular group or as part of a school trip for Heritage Collegiate. It is important that all students understand that being a member of an extra-curricular club, team, or group is a privilege and not a right. With the privilege of these groups/events comes important responsibilities.

Students given the privilege to participate in extra-curricular teams, groups, trips, or events do so with a high-level of responsibility and expectation from the school.

The following is a list of expectations for students who wish to participate in extra-curricular groups and events with Heritage Collegiate:

- 1) Students must recognize that their primary responsibility in school is to achieve academically. To remain on a music, robotics, or sports team/club, etc. or to participate in any extra-curricular group or trip means you are required to be up to date on school work and be working to the best of your ability as deemed acceptable by the school's administration.
- 2) Attendance, good behavior, and cooperation at school and with your team/group are a must. Non-compliance may result in suspension or even dismissal from an extra-curricular group or activity.
- 3) Any member of a team or club that is found to be participating in any activity that is contrary to the schools Code of Conduct or Assessment and Evaluation Policy, including academic dishonesty, may be removed from any or all extra-curricular groups/ events for the remainder of the year.
- 4) If you are too sick to attend school, you are too sick to attend any practice/ team/ sporting event/ Tournament/ or extra-curricular activity on the same day. You must be in attendance at school on the day in order to participate in afterschool events of any kind. If you are absent for a medical appointment, a note will be required.
- 5) Many extra-curricular groups include trips and public events at Heritage Collegiate or at other locations. You are expected to be a good ambassador for your school. Your conduct should be mature and appropriate for the event you are attending. You represent your school at these events, people are watching, and they may not remember you but they will remember your school.

- 6) All students, but especially those involved in extra-curricular groups, are expected to be responsible, courteous, and respectful. Abusive or foul language will not be tolerated. You shall behave at all functions as you would be expected to behave in school.
- 7) Smoking, vaping, drinking and/or use of drugs is strictly prohibited. Students who break this rule will be removed from one or all extra-curricular teams, groups, or events for the remainder of the year.
- 8) Being a member of extra-curricular team or group requires commitment. You will be expected to attend all practices and events/tournaments/games on a regular basis and be punctual.
- 9) Any expenses for events you attend (concerts, games and tournaments, etc.) will be shared amongst team players. This will cover transportation, registration fees, players fees, etc. Amounts will vary depending on location and event. Expenses may be paid using school accounts, cash, or cheque made payable to Heritage Collegiate.

If you are willing to accept the above terms, then we are pleased to have you represent Heritage Collegiate and participate in our extra-curricular teams and activities.

By signing this document, you indicate your willingness to abide by the terms outlined herein and recognize that the schools administration has final say in your participation in any extra-curricular activity.
